



Prince George's County

Health Report

There are over 900,000 residents in Prince George's County.

- 10% have no health insurance (over 90,000 people).
- The leading cause of death in Prince George's County is Heart Disease, followed by cancer, and stroke.
- For every 100,000 residents, 55.6% have a reported diagnosis of HIV (13 and over). 85.8% of reported cases are African Americans.
- 50,000 county residents have experienced major depression.
- There is 1 primary doctor for every 1,910 residents, and 1 primary care dentist for every 1,680 residents.
- Lack of transportation is the #1 reason residents listed for not going to a doctor.
