INTERNSHIP POSITIONS

All internships are unpaid and are offered in the fall, spring, and summer. There are several types of internships available.

- **Digital Design** Students will assist in graphic design content. Must have advanced knowledge of Adobe Creative Suite with a focus on Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Dreamweaver, and Premier. Must have access to design software. WordPress and Print Media knowledge strongly encouraged. The applicant must submit a Portfolio of at least 5 pieces with application. Must be a Collaborative Worker and Design Problem Solver. **(This internship is only open to students classified as Juniors, Seniors, and Graduate students.)**
- **Digital Media** Students will assist in the stations' daily web needs including designing web graphics, advertisements, publishing content, videography, social media management, and other duties assigned. Knowledge of HTML, Adobe Photoshop, and Illustrator is a plus. (Candidates should enjoy writing and be able to write effectively. Candidates should also have videography and editing skills.)
- **Music** (Must be able to write and manage Social Media)
- Programming- Students will assist in on-air work including social media, show research for the Afternoon Drive show or
 work on social media in the Music Department. Students must be available between the hours of 9:30am-1:30pm for
 the midday show and for the afternoon drive show.
- Promotions students will assist in stations promotional needs including logging merchandise, creating social media
 plans, packaging prizes, as well as on site event assistance.
- Videography Students will assist in shooting and editing videos for websites and social media platforms. Students must have experience in Final Cut Pro editing software. This internship is only open to students classified as Juniors and Seniors
- News/Public Affairs students will assist in show research, writing copy, booking guests, and other news related duties. (Candidates should have an interest in journalism, news, reporting, and community service. They must also be able to write and think critically.)
- Website/ Web Developer Students will assist in web and mobile app development and building user interfaces. Students must be proficient in HTML and CSS and must have knowledge of WordPress and PHP. (This internship is only open to students classified as Juniors, Seniors, and Graduate students.)

QUALIFICATIONS

To be considered for an internship within the Network, one must:

- 1. Be a registered student at Howard University (Non-Howard students may only apply for summer internships)
- 2. Be in good academic standing (at least 2.5 GPA)
- 3. Students seeking an internship for class credit must be registered in one of the **practicum classes and be a graduating senior**.
- 4. Students seeking a Web Design internship must submit a portfolio.

- 6. Practicum and Non-practicum Internship Applications must be submitted by January 18th by 8pm.
