INTERNSHIP POSITIONS

All internships are unpaid and are offered in the fall, spring, and summer. There are several types of internships available.

- Programming- Students will assist in on-air work including social media, show research for the Midday show or Afternoon Drive show. Students must be available between the hours of 9:30am-1:30pm for the midday show or 1:30pm-5:30pm for the afternoon drive show.
- Promotions students will assist in stations promotional needs including logging merchandise, creating social media
 plans, packaging prizes, as well as on site event assistance.
- News/Public Affairs students will assist in show research, writing copy, booking guests, and other news related duties.
 (Candidates should have an interest in journalism, news, reporting, and community service. They must also be able to write and think critically.)
- Social Media Students will assist in social media content including writing and creating content for digital platforms.

COMMERCIAL STATIONS

To be considered for an internship within the Network, one must:

- 1. Be a registered student at Howard University (Non-Howard students may only apply for summer internships)
- 2. Be in good academic standing (at least 2.5 GPA)
- 3. Students seeking an internship for class credit must be registered in one of the **practicum classes and be a graduating senior**.
- 4. Students seeking an internship with Glasshouse Radio must contact Diamond Sydnor at dsydnor@whur.com. Students interested in WHBC must contact them directly at gm.whbc@gmail.com.
- 5. Practicum and Non-practicum Internship Applications must be submitted by Friday, January 19, 2024 at 8pm EST.
