#### **INTERNSHIP POSITIONS**

All internships are unpaid and are offered in the fall, spring, and summer. There are several types of internships available.

- **Programming** Students will assist in on-air work, including social media and show research for the Afternoon Drive show. (Students must be available between the hours of 1:30pm-5:30pm for the Afternoon Drive show.)
- **Promotions** students will assist in stations promotional needs including logging merchandise, creating social media plans, packaging prizes, as well as on site event assistance.
- Social Media Students will assist in social media content including writing and creating content for digital platforms.
- · Sales Students will learn about and assist with radio advertisements.

#### **COMMERCIAL STATIONS**

To be considered for an internship within the Network, one must:

- 1. Be a registered student at Howard University (Non-Howard students may only apply for summer internships)
- 2. Be in good academic standing (at least 2.5 GPA)
- 3. Students seeking an internship for class credit must be registered in one of the **practicum classes and be a graduating senior**.
- 4. Students seeking an internship with Glasshouse Radio must contact Diamond Sydnor at dsydnor@whur.com. Students interested in WHBC must contact them directly at gm.whbc@gmail.com.
- 5. Practicum and Non-practicum Internship Applications must be submitted by Friday, January 24, 2025 at 8pm EST.
